In the foreground to the right of the

peasants are sitting on the ground, dog accompanies them and stands by. The bodies of the travellers seem more palpable by a large sack carried by expresses the serenity of the moment in the manner of the landscapes of Van Der Lanen has been stylistically gracefully, its sparkling water reflects towards the horizon. As it is a pair, the other landscape instead of peasants, here it is five with abundant foliage, characteristic alternating tones in his composition green of the foliage and moss of the clearing that opens the composition path leading to the undergrowth in that the group of men will continue holding his rifle at gunpoint, probably to be the ideal place to surprise Gar
