The bronze ornamentation is of great adorning the apron with its beautiful shaped pull handles decorated with scroll-like floral motifs, and the great

The top is crowned with a fine Flemish curved across the entire surface to

This type of composition, both in the ornamentation, allows for attribution to the court and the great aristocratic
